

CPR Classes for Spring 2012 Semester

American Heart Association –BLS-Healthcare Provider

For Nursing and Health Studies Majors who are entering into clinical during the spring 2012 semester

The American Heart Association CPR –BLS-Healthcare Provider classes will be held at Mount Aloysius College on the following dates and times listed below.

The clinical education fee will cover the cost of the CPR class if it has not been previously used for CPR for the following students: **Nursing, Medical Imaging , Medical Imaging Ultrasonography, Physical Therapy Assistant Sophomore, Medical Assistant Sophomore, Medical Lab Technology Sophomore, and Surgical Technology Sophomore, who will be in clinical during the fall semester. A current CPR certification is required for all Health Studies and Nursing Students who are participating at a clinical location. Pre-Nursing and Pre-Health Studies students should not take the CPR class at this time. If you take the class and are not entering clinical the certification will expire during your last semester.** The American Heart Association certification is good for two years before expiring.

The cost of the class will be \$40.00 for anyone who does not have the clinical education fee. You will need to pay for the class before being admitted into the class. Please bring your receipt with you the day of the class. Students who do not have the clinical education fee must have a receipt with proof of payment, or you will not be able to take the class.

Cancellations must be called into Health Services 48 hours in advance to 814-886-6391 or 814-886-6515. If you sign up for the class and do not cancel within 48 hours your clinical education fee will be charged, and/or there will be no refunds for the class.

Registration is required for classes at least two weeks in advance. Classes with enrollment of less than 10 participants will be canceled. We will notify you so that you can register in another class. Medical Imaging, and Medical Lab Technology Students have designated class times. You will be scheduled according to the class roster. However, if you are absent for the CPR class, the cancellation policy still applies. Nursing Level 1 students, Physical Therapy Sophomores, Medical Assistant Sophomores, and Surgical Tech Sophomores are required to call in to Health Services to schedule for CPR during one of the August classes. If you have received CPR at another location and are submitting a CPR card it must not expire during the semester. We highly recommend American Heart Association certification. We **cannot** accept the American Heart Association Heartsaver certification. This certification is not for health care professionals. All certifications must be for Professional Rescuer BLS, adult, child, infant, and AED.

Class will be held in the rooms listed below. During inclement weather CPR classes will follow the same schedule as the college. If the college is closed the classes will be canceled and you will be contacted with a new date and time. If the college remains open the classes will be held, and the cancellation information stated above will apply.
